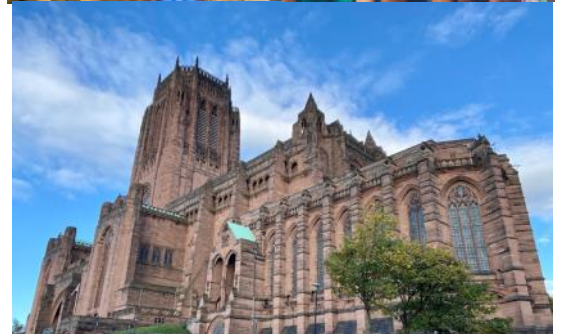
**Reverend Janettarose
