

Mother Sara joined St Mary's as Senior Associate Rector in June 2020. After ordination, she worked as an Assistant for six years at Saint Mary's in High Point, North Carolina, and then as Rector of Holy Trinity, Oxford, Ohio (home of Miami University) for four years prior to coming to Arlington. Mother Sara speaks fluent French and Spanish; she has taught these modern languages in addition to German. She also knows Latin, Greek and Hebrew.

David is a music professor and church musician; he is a piano teacher, does a weekly radio show of 60's music, and gigs with various bands; he has volunteered with the Reading and Writing program associated with Santa Maria. She is deeply thankful to God to be working as part of the clergy team and staff at Saint Mary's, Arlington.
